What program(s) did you previously take at Keyano?

- I graduated from the Primary Care Paramedic program

Tell me about life after graduation and your journey to get to where you are now – enrolled back at Keyano in Nursing.

- I have been so fortunate to have had the "best of both worlds" pursuing my love for medicine and my love for sport. After graduation, I had the opportunity to turn my part time student job with the SSWC into a full time position working with high performance athletes and Huskies Athletics. From there, I continued to have amazing opportunities in sport working with the Alberta Games, Arctic Winter Games and the Western Canada Summer games for almost a decade, but in my heart I always knew that nursing was my ultimate goal. I started the BSCN program in September 2022 and finished my final sport contract with the 2023 Wood Buffalo Arctic Winter Games in March 2023. I have truly had such a special journey with sport, but I am so excited to enter this new phase of my life!

Why did you decide to come back to Keyano as opposed to going to any other school?

- I am very fortunate that Keyano College offers the BSCN program because Fort McMurray is my home, I would not have been able to take this program anywhere else. From my experience as a staff member, I know what a special place Keyano is and I am very fortunate to return once again as a student and a part time staff member with the Syncrude Sport & Wellness Centre.

What advice would you give Keyano students and alumni?

- Education is never wasted! Pursue anything your heart desires and if you change your mind - do something else. I am so grateful for all of the education and experience I have gained along the way because it ultimately led me to where I am now and the timing is perfect. Life is full of challenges and opportunities, but if something you want really scares you, just do it scared!
