

## **Course Outline**

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### **Course Description**

This course applies experiential learning concepts while working within a health care facility. Students will apply theoretical knowledge when completing patient care. Clinical practicums will occur in the Emergency Department.

Emphasis is on making the student part of the local health care team, while practicing at an appropriate Basic Life Support (BLS) standard.

### **Course Outcomes**

The student will be able to:

- Demonstrate familiarity with the hospital environment including policies and procedures.
- Participate as a member of an interdisciplinary health care team.
- Practice mandatory competencies and have them signed off by preceptor.
- Document patient care including assessments, history and treatments.
- Articulate the role of pre-hospital care professional in the health system.

### **Evaluation**

For successful completion of this course, students must:

1. Complete a minimum of 36 hours in the hospital setting.
2. Successfully complete and be signed off for all mandatory competencies for the minimum number of times outlined in the Hospital Practicum Booklet.
3. Successfully complete and document the final evaluation form in the Hospital Practicum Booklet.
4. Return the completed practicum booklet to Keyano College.
5. Ensure all information is up-to-date in CompTracker® and this information verifies the successful completion of the mandatory competencies.
