

CANADA-ALBERTA JOB GRANT (CAJG)

The Canada-Alberta Job Grant is an Alberta government funding program offering employers training grants.

Eligible employers contribute at least one-third of the total training costs for existing employees. The government contributes two-thirds of the cost to a maximum of \$10,000 per trainee per fiscal year.

If hiring and training an unemployed Albertan, up to 100% of training costs could be covered, up to \$15,000 per trainee.

GRANT PROCESS

The Canada-Alberta Job Grant program is a two-step process:

- Step 1: Employers fill out and submit a CAJG application through Alberta Labour and Immigration's Workforce Grants Portal available at alberta.ca/CAJG.
- Step 2: Once the training has ended, employers fill out and submit a Training Completion form to receive payment.

ELIGIBLE EMPLOYERS

The CAIG is available to:

- private sector employers, including sole proprietors and partnerships
- non-profit sector employers
- First Nations and Metis Settlements
- the Agriculture Financial Services Corporation (if in a community with a population of 100,000 or less)
- Alberta Treasury Branches (if in a community with a population of 100,000 or less)

To be eligible, Alberta employers must have current or potential employees who need training to fill current or future positions.

ELIGIBLE TRAINEES

All eligible trainees must live in Alberta. CAJG trainees must be one of the following:

- Canadian citizens
- permanent residents
- · protected people under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (Canada) who are entitled to work in Canada
- business owners (incorporated, unincorporated, sole-proprietor, partnerships) with 4 or fewer employees, including all owners, are now eligible trainees
- employed family members

Your organization (if eligible) can apply for the Canada Alberta Job Grant toward:

- tuition
- instructional fees
- · mandatory student fees
- examination fees
- textbooks
- software
- · any other required materials directly relevant to the training





POWER ENGINEERING

Keyano College offers Power Lab Courses and Preparatory Math for Power Engineers.

POWER LAB 40 HOUR COURSE

This is a one week program that will credit you with 40 of 200 hours required in the Power Lab 200 Hour Course. It is provided to students unable to commit to the full five weeks. This course is broken down into week 1, week 2, week 3, week 4 and week 5 and is required to complete over 12 months.

POWER LAB 200 HOUR COURSE

The Power Lab 200 Hour Course will help you acquire your 4th Class Power Engineering Certification if you have completed your Part A and B theory courses, but do not have the six-month stream experience needed to become certified. The course is offered as an interactive training lab. Once you have successfully completed the course, you will be eligible to write the Alberta Boilers Safety Association (ABSA) 4A and 4B exams to become certified.


Fall, Winter and Spring intakes are available for Power Lab courses.

PREPARATORY MATH COURSE

It is suggested students have successfully completed either Math 20-1 or Math 20-2 prior to taking this course.
