DIPLOMA AND CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

DIPLOMA PROGRAMS

Our diploma programs will provide you with the credentials you need to excel in your career. You can choose from a number of different diploma programs offered at Keyano College.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION DIPLOMA

This program provides a comprehensive introduction to, and study of, the concepts, principles and practices of business, accounting, marketing and management. Under the Diploma, students can choose to specialize in management, Accounting, or business Esports. Under Management and Accounting, a co-op program is also available.

BUSINESS AVIATION DIPLOMA

The Business Aviation Diploma program is for learners who are interested in pursuing a career in aviation business operations. This two year diploma program provides students with business knowledge along with the aviation training component with Transport Canada standards. Through successful acquisition of both a private and commercial pilot's license within the program, graduates may pursue career specializations in northern aviation operations or airline operations.

EARLY LEARNING AND CHILD CARE DIPLOMA

The Early Learning and Child Care Diploma provides students with the knowledge, skills, and competencies to pursue professional, supervisory positions in childcare

ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNOLOGY CO-OP DIPLOMA

The Environmental Technology program focuses on the environmental issues, problems and solutions that are associated with the natural resource industries of northern Alberta.

GENERAL SCIENCE IN COMPUTER SYSTEMS TECHNOLOGY

The Computing Science programs at Keyano College offer students an opportunity to integrate extensive software development skills with an emphasis in various programs include computer graphics and image processing, digital hardware, data communications and networking.

GOVERNANCE AND CIVIL STUDIES DIPLOMA

The Governance and Civil Studies diploma prepares students to work in the areas of government, politics, public administration, and civil society (NGOs) with a special focus on Indigenous politics and governance

HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT DIPLOMA

Developed with input from industry experts, students gain practical experience, while learning from and networking with industry professionals, within our regional hospitality and tourism organizations. Graduates of the Hospitality Management program may pursue supervisory level careers in global hospitality and tourism sectors such as hotels, restaurants, resorts, cruise lines, tourism development and marketing organizations and similar organizations, become entrepreneurs, event planners and tour organizers.

HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT DIPLOMA

The Human Resource Management (HRM) Diploma will provide graduates with necessary skills and experiences for entry to supervisory-level careers in organizational human resource management. Learners are exposed to HRM specific topics as well to general business management topics, thus preparing them to be valuable contributors in a variety of organizational settings or also as individual HR consultants.

PRACTICAL NURSE DIPLOMA

The two-year Practical Nurse program will prepare students for a career in high quality nursing care in many different settings: hospitals, home care, and other health care agencies.

SOCIAL WORK DIPLOMA

This Social Work Diploma program will equip students with the social work competencies required to enter the work force as beginning social work practitioners. Completion of the Social Work Diploma program will prepare and enable students to continue their education in a Bachelor of Social Work program at various Universities.

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

Keyano College offers courses and programs that award certificates. These certificates give you the skills and credentials you need to be successful in the area you are interested in.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION CERTIFICATES

This program provides a comprehensive introduction to, and study of, the concepts, principles and practices of business, accounting, marketing, and management. Under the Certificate, students can choose to specialize in management or accounting.

EDUCATION ASSISTANT CERTIFICATE

The Childhood Studies department offers a full-time, ten-month Educational Assistant where graduates are employed primarily in schools or community programs working with children with special needs.

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES CERTIFICATE

The English for Academic Purposes program will provide learners with English language instruction for pursuing further academic study in Canadian post-secondary institutions.

GENERAL ARTS CERTIFICATE

The General Arts certificate at Keyano College provides students with the opportunity to acquire the essential knowledge and skills required in college, university, and the workforce.

GENERAL SCIENCE CERTIFICATE

The General Science Certificate at Keyano College provides students with the opportunity to acquire the essential knowledge and skills required in college, university, and the workforce.

GENERAL SCIENCE IN COMPUTER SYSTEMS TECHNOLOGY CERTIFICATE

The Computing Science programs at Keyano College offer students an opportunity to integrate extensive software development skills with hardware skills.

HEALTH CARE AID CERTIFICATE

The Health Care Aide program is a 32-week program that provides students with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes they need to practice as a Health Care Aide.

OFFICE ADMINISTRATION CERTIFICATE

The Office Administration program has been tailored to serve the needs of both small businesses and large industrial employers. In preparation for employment, students learn the skills necessary to manage an electronic office environment for small to medium-sized businesses.

TRADES AND APPRENTICESHIP

TRADES

Hands on training, taught by skilled trades professionals, will give you the skills you need for a successful career.

POWER ENGINEERING FOURTH CLASS COMPREHENSIVE

Power Engineers operate, maintain, and manage industrial plants that use equipment such as boilers and refrigeration units

POWER ENGINEERING THIRD CLASS CO-OP

Power Engineers operate, maintain, and manage industrial plants that use equipment such as boilers and refrigeration units. A successful 4th Class ABSA certificate is required for this program.

POWER ENGINEERING CML 4TH CLASS

The program is delivered through an online platform which is a computer managed, self-paced course done at your convenience.

POWER ENGINEERING CML 3RD CLASS

This program is open to any individual with an Alberta Fourth Class Power Engineering Certificate. The program is delivered through an online platform which is a computer managed, self-paced course done at your convenience.



APPRENTICESHIPS

Keyano offers several types of technical training for apprentices and a wide variety of heavy industrial occupations to make you job ready.

ELECTRICIAN

Electricians install, alter, repair and maintain electrical systems designed to provide heat, light, power, control, signal or fire alarms for all types of buildings, structures and premises.

HEAVY EQUIPMENT TECHNICIAN

Heavy equipment technicians maintain, repair, and overhaul heavy vehicles and industrial equipment.

INDUSTRIAL MECHANIC

Industrial Mechanics install, maintain, repair and troubleshoot stationary industrial machinery and mechanical equipment in sites such as factories, production plants and recreational facilities.

STEAMFITTER/PIPEFITTER

Steamfitter/Pipefitter lay out, assemble, fabricate, maintain and repair piping systems which carry water, steam, chemicals or fuel used in heating, cooling, lubricating and other processes.

WELDER

Welders join or sever metals in beams, girders, vessels, piping and other metal components, make metal parts used in construction and manufacturing plants, and weld parts, tools, machines and equipment.

UNIVERSITY PROGRAMS

COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMS

Keyano College offers collaborative degree programs to provide students with a unique opportunity to obtain a comprehensive education that bridges educational institutions in order to provide students with a success career and future while completing their degree in Fort McMurray, AB.

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Students can complete years three and four of the Bachelor of Business Administration (Management) degree in collaboration with NAIT. Successful transfer is based on proper course selection, credit hours completed, grade point average, and other requirements.



BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING

The Keyano College Nursing department in collaboration with the University of Alberta offers a four-year baccalaureate program at Keyano College. Upon graduation, students will be awarded a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from the University of Alberta.



BACHELOR OF EDUCATION ELEMENTARY DEGREE

Students may complete their entire four-year Bachelor of Education Elementary degree at Keyano College campus through a collaborative degree process with the University of Alberta. Upon completion, students receive a Bachelor of Education Elementary degree from the University of Alberta.

TRANSFER PROGRAMS

Keyano College offers up to one or two years of transferable university coursework towards a variety of degree programs. Students need to meet the admission requirements set by the receiving institution, but Keyano College offers courses that can transfer to the University of Alberta, University of Lethbridge, Mount Royal University, University of Calgary, and other successful degree-granting institutions.

BACHELOR OF ARTS

Students can complete up to two years (60 credits) of the Bachelor of Arts degree at Keyano College.

BACHELOR OF COMMERCE

Students can complete up to two years (60 credits) of the Bachelor of Commerce degree at Keyano College. The Bachelor of Commerce program will provide students with background skills and knowledge in the various specialized areas of business, as well as in the humanities and social sciences.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE

Students can complete up to two years (60 credits) towards "General" or "Honours & Specialization" programs, which can be transferred to a degree-granting institution.

BACHELOR OF SOCIAL WORK

Students can complete two years of the Bachelor of Social Work degree at Keyano College.

BACHELOR OF ENGINEERING





Students can complete year one of the University of Alberta Bachelor of Science in Engineering program at Keyano College. Selection of a specialization takes place in the second year.







BACHELOR OF EDUCATION SECONDARY DEGREE

Students interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Education Secondary Degree can complete one to two years of their program at Keyano College campus and then transfer to the University of Alberta. Please note, successful transfer is based on proper course selection, credit hours completed, grade point average, and other requirements.

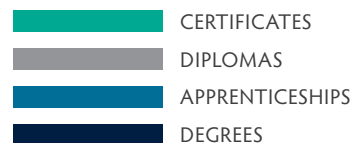
