There are some preparatory requirements needed prior to this learning. All students must comply with the mandatory list of requirements below.

*Please take time prior to starting the program to complete these tasks.

Read the Social Work Student Handbook

- All new students are required to read the attached Social Work Handbook and have all signed documents submitted to a faculty member by September 14, 2024
- Review and complete of the Confidentiality Agreement pp. 37-38
- Review and complete Statement of Verification and Agreement p.39
- Review and Complete Photo/Video Release document p.40

Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Clearance

- All Domestic and International students are required to provide Keyano College with a Police Information Check and Vulnerable Sector Checks. You will need to provide these checks 3 times during the 2-year program:
 - 1) start of the program
 - 2) prior to first practicum
 - 3) prior to second Practicum.

- Please submit the <u>original</u> of your Police Information Check, with Vulnerable Sector Clearance to the Health & Human Services Office CC186 by <u>September 28, 2024</u>, the associated costs are your responsibility.
- ALL photocopies of Police Information Checks should be made prior to submission of the originals as the department will not provide photocopies.
- During enrolment in the program, you must self-report any change in criminal convictions or criminal charges to the Chairperson of the Social Work department.
- Where a Police Check shows any one or more boxes checked off indicating that information "may or may not exist" you will be directed to consult with the Chairperson of the Social Work department for further information.

Complete Child Youth Intervention Record Check

- All Domestic and International students are required to provide Keyano College with a Child Youth Intervention Record Check. You will need to provide these checks 3 times during the 2-year program:
 - 1) start of the program
 - 2) prior to first practicum
 - 3) prior to second Practicum.

- Please submit a paper copy of your Child Youth Intervention Record Check to the Health & Human Services Office CC186 by **September 28, 2024,** there is no associated costs with this check.
